
## Processing techniques

We use different processing techniques depending on what final product is required. A number of circular saws are often used in order to pass the block on in the chain of production.

The octagon shape is needed so the block can be processed in the lathe; that will give the basin its rounded shape.

At the images to the right, you can clearly see the veins in the marble bock.

# Durable material Image 1.4

Marble is a very durable material, in the sense of its sustainability and long lasting when properly maintained. It is also very grateful material to work with: most of the processing is a manual work, which requires many years of professional skills.

### Diversity Image 1:5

Character diversity doesn't mean one character is better than another character. The veins, texture and colour is what gives the marble its character. We don't modify the material itself, we just process it with great care.
